

Perhaps not many know, but at the United Nations Muslim Countries team up with the predominantly Christian or Catholic countries, together with the Vatican to promote life issues or defeat shocking socially detrimental bills that would otherwise promote abortion, undermine the status of the family and gender identity politics.

Just this last week, leaders from the three principal monotheistic religions (believe in one God) -Christians, Muslims and Jews - issued a joint declaration against euthanasia ('mercy' killing) and


