Sunday after the Nativity

In a couple of days we will begin a journey into a new year. It will be a long trip, but a truly exciting one as there are limitless possibilities (really there are limitless possibilities... it depends on how bold we are ready to be and how much we are ready to listen to the voice of our Lord and trust Him...). As when we travel anywhere of some longer distance nowadays, we have to consider a few things. One is - how much luggage do we REALLY need to bring with us!? If we bring too much, we will just exhaust ourselves lugging it around all the time and probably inconvenience ourselves and fellow travellers by having to mind it all the time. And... we will probably pay dearly for bringing all that stuff with us. The same should be considered as we travel into the year 2020. Let's decide now what we really need and what we DO **NOT** have to bring with us. There are probably some material things and maybe relationships as well as attitudes and grudges and fears that we just don't need. Let's lose them, by the grace of God, for once and for all and stop lugging them around. Another thing is when we get to customs or even travel security control we will be asked about forbidden things and/or they will be detected. Usually they are forbidden because the travel agency

considers them "dangerous" to fellow travellers or to the country of destination. Again, we need to make similar decisions as we are about to enter a new year. Some things truly are dangerous and not needed. Sharp objects like an acid tongue or cruel comments or poisonous gossip should not be brought for the journey. Any weapons that would harms others unjustly should be left behind. Yet, maybe some armour like that described by St Paul should be taken along (Ephesians 6:13-17) to ensure a safe journey to and at our destination. Then (are you sitting down?) maybe some things could be "smuggled" in, as they are not dangerous at all, even if some totalitarian authorities deem them to be. (Did he really just say that!?) This is.... your Faith, your Catechism, your constant prayer-life, the Word of God - your Bible, your Rosary, your Catholic values, etc. Yes, for these things in some totalitarian countries people have been fined or even arrested. We too want to be bold and carry such things with us as we enter 2020, regardless of the consequences, because we know that we need them and we want to share them with those who we meet in our travels... Happy 2020!


