My Dearly-Beloved Brothers and Sisters in Christ!

Today you have graciously received your parish priest and the Jordan water into your hospitable home. Allow me to be your guest as well and impart on you my blessing — for protection against all adversaries, for the fulfillment of all your good intentions, in joy and love.

In our tradition the feast to commemorate Christ's Baptism is called Theophany, because it is the first time that God revealed Himself as Trinity: the Father, who allows his Voice to be heard, the Beloved Son, who in the Jordan waters receives his mission, the Holy Spirit, who in the form of a dove let's us know that He accompanies the Son in all things. And because we be-

lieve in a God who is community, we Christians are also called to live in community and be community.

Our vocation — to grow together in faith, holiness and service, supporting one another. In our families — with joy, harmony and love. In our parishes — with a sense of that which makes our parish vibrant and a place to encounter the living Christ. In our eparchies — with a spirit of prayer and cooperation, lead by a good Pastor, our Bishop. In our particular Ukrainian Greek-Catholic Church — in spiritual unity and active solidarity with one another, wherever we may live. In the Universal Catholic Church — in full communion with the Vicar of Christ on earth, bearing witness to a common faith and a life according to the Gospel.

My task, as Father and Head of our Church, is to be watchful over all these centers of unity. Today, therefore, my blessing for this home is that you all grow together in the knowledge of our faith, that you pray together each day and that together who do the Lord's good works, sustained by Christ in the Holy Eucharist, and by your active participation in the parish community, to which you belong.

I bless this home and all who live in it — in the name of the Father, and the Son, and the Holy Spirit., Amen.

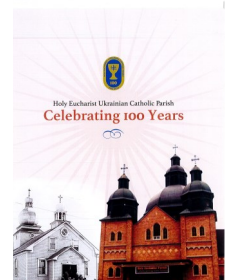
