# Witnessing to our Faith, Standing up for our elderly and infirm

The present government of Canada (that's our country in which we are living, not a movie, not on the other side of the world) wants to extend euthanasia access to even more people. Their plan is to reduce the safeguards and the amount of information and consultation that is now required before administering lethal drugs that will end the life of individuals that have signed off on M.A.I.D. (Medical Assistance in Dying). The original narrative was that assisted suicide (that's what it is) was being offered to those that were terminally ill (dying soon anyway) and/or having to deal with chronic suffering (and considered continuous pain-control methods as unpleasant or unbearable). Some 6,700 Canadians have died with MAID so far. Now they want to make it easier for this civilized murder to become more mainstream. They want less wait time requirements, less information and less doublechecking if the individual has changed her/his mind, less reason for wanting to be killed - terminal illness need not be the reason, just... the person is, say, depressed or feeling dejected and wants to end it. How many people are lonely and made to feel that they are not a blessing to their children, but rather a bother or a burden. Is that the truth? Of course not, but society makes us so busy and dictates what a 'happy' or 'successful' life is all about. And we, rather than telling the world what life is all about, we buy into the world's selfish, mad version of working insane hours to buy things that aren't really needed but just take up more of our time and give us less time for people - people that brought us into this world, and people that we will never really get to know, because we are too busy living in a fake world of internet and movies and video games, and people that really need us and for whom we can make a life-long or eternal difference by reaching out to them and giving them time.
