WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY: ANOTHER STEP FORWARD



The 2020 annual Week of Pray for Christian Unity concluded in Winnipeg yesterday. The proposed theme for that last day was "Generosity: Receiving and Giving" with Scripture readings being: Acts 28:8-10; Psalm 103:1-5 and Matthew 10:7-8. It was supposed to be an at-home day of personal or family reflection and prayer. However, here at Holy Eucharist Parish on Saturday morning we were blessed with a small, but inspiring ecumenical event of our own. A local **Mennonite** community asked to come see our church and learn a bit more about us and how we pray. Our Metropolitan **Lawrence** even joined us and some ladies from the parish prepared a light lunch with—of course—a Ukrainian flavour. It is interesting to note that Mennonites in their migrant journey, because of persecution of their beliefs beginning in 1536, have spent time in northern Poland and south-eastern **Ukraine**. It is interesting to note that they also experienced similar hardships and persecution as the local Ukrainian population under Tsarist and later Communist Russia (even though it was *Tsarina Catherine that first encouraged them to settle in Ukraine*). They settled especially on the famous massive **Khortytsia** island in the middle of the vast Dnipro River - the once legendary stronghold of the Ukrainian Cossacks (Kozak). Things change. The Tsarist government began to pressure them. They started to look to distant lands in which they could live in peace. The Mennonites started to settle in Manitoba about the same time as Ukrainians. The Communist revolution and the devastation of the world wars (and their being tugged back and forth and exiled during those wars) saw practically all Mennonites leave Ukrainian lands and resettle in various places in the U.S. and Canada. Google the Mennonite Church in Manitoba and via various sites, you will probably be amazed at the religious and cultural history and their faith beliefs.
