COVID-19 PROVISIONARY PARISH WEEKLY UPDATE - NO. 11

FEAST OF THE HOLY EUCHARIST 2020

You know what!? Regardless of any pandemic or social restrictions or isolation fatigue (or laziness?) or prolonged fear that may be tempting us, to paralyze us, **we need to celebrate!** We celebrate the awesome gift of the Sacrament of the Holy Eucharist with, well yes, **awe**, but also with great **joy** and due **solemnity** and **praise** and **thanksgiving** and **singing**. But the best way to truly celebrate the Holy Eucharist is by **full** and **worthy** participation. And how do we achieve that? By doing our best to **attend** the Divine Liturgy (*every day even, but at least*) on Sunday, and to **worthily** receive our Lord in **Holy Communion**. How can we expand on that? First, by the most basic rules - i.e. **fasting** at *least* an hour before the Divine Liturgy, coming **on time** and **not rushing** out afterward, preparing spiritually by going to **Confession** regularly and certainly if we know that there is something on our conscience and soul for which we need to come clean before the Lord. By praying before hand at home and on the way to church. By discussing **"what just happened!?"** on the way home and for the rest of the day! It would be really good to prepare by finding the Scripture readings (Epistle and Gospel of the day) and reading them and even looking at the Bible commentary and thinking about them. When you hear the Homily (a.k.a. Sermon) in church, you can compare ideas and then even ask the priest why he chose the ideas that he did to preach on and tell him your ideas. And/or you can discuss that with your husband, your wife, your children, your parents - i.e. with your family! Yeah, get Baba and Dido involved and Uncle Slawko. You want a challenging theme!? What does the **Holy Eucharist** (the Sacrament, but also the Parish) offer as a **solution** to the coronavirus pandemic and to the social problems that we now face - the most obvious one right now - **racism!**? Really. Now *that* is something to think about and talk about and see that there really is a strong link to both! Let's celebrate the Lord's greatest gift and draw nearer to Him!...

Holy Eucharist Parish "Reopening" plan.

What to do...

1. Offer a prayer of thanksgiving to the Lord that we are able to slowly return to our beloved parish church. AND pray that the Holy Spirit will guide and watch over our return that we will be cautious and that everyone will understand the importance of following the protocols.

2. Read the full text of the Archeparchial reopening **Covid-19 Directive #5** and the accompanying **Commentary** on the Archeparchial website at www.archeparchy.ca.

3. Ask yourself the usual safety **questions** and if, and only if, you can answer "**No**" to all four, and you would like to attend a service or visit the church, then call the parish to "preregister". The four questions are:

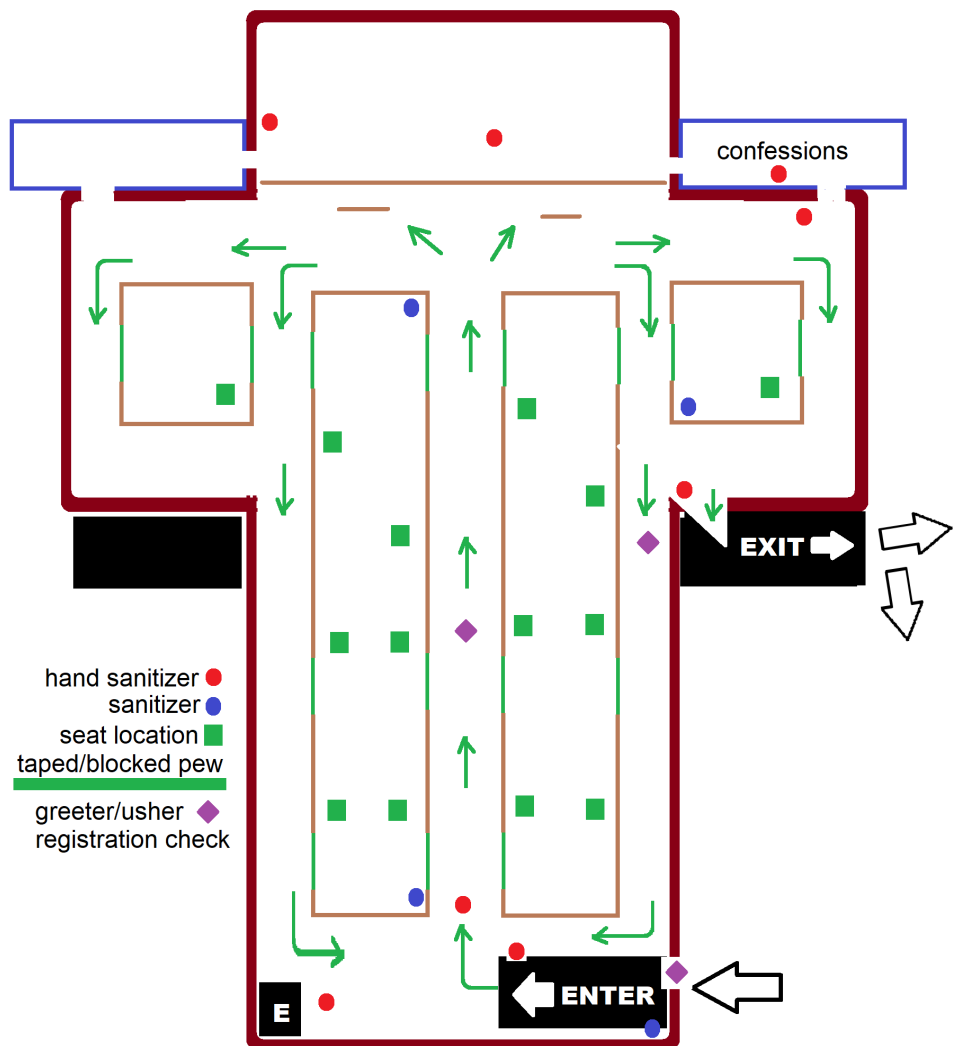
► Did I travel by air in the past two weeks? ► Have I been close to someone infected with COVID-19? ► Is anyone in my household quarantined or in isolation? ► Do I have a cough, fever, shortness of breath, runny nose, or sore throat?

4. You can **pre-register** to participate in a **Sunday Divine Liturgy** for yourself (and other family members) by calling the parish office **204-667-8866** and letting the Office Manager know or by leaving a message by the previous Friday noon. (you can also use the **Eventbrite** app on the parish website. You will need to clarify **which Divine Liturgy** you would like to attend [8:00 am or 10:00 am], **who** will be attending [name and contact number] and confirm that you can answer the **safety questions** negatively. The limit at this time is **only 25 persons** (including clergy, singers and ushers) so when that number is met for each Liturgy, no more pre-registrations will be accepted. *(One option is to have more Liturgies - for example, an additional noon service - if warranted. We will see how that develops)*

5. Arrive at the church **at least 10 minutes prior** to the service. (If others have expressed a desire to attend a certain liturgy and a pre-registered individual(s) has not arrived in time, the usher may admit another if he/she is able to confirm No. 3 above).

6. **Follow all the instructions** given by the ushers and the presiding member of the clergy. Keep in mind... use **hand sanitizer** when entering the church and when leaving.... keep at a **distance of 6-feet** from other individuals at all times... follow the directional **arrows** (forward only up the middle and back only by the sides)... sit only in "**open**" pews and at a spot tagged by **green tape**... individuals from the same household may sit in one pew... help to sanitize your own spot (seat and the top/back of the pew in front of you)... wearing a **mask** or having one to use is very much *encouraged*... there is **one entrance** and a **different exit**... (with the exception of those who need the handicap elevator)... **no socializing** can be permitted at this time in the church or in the church parking lot (there will be a time soon enough)...

It's not that complicated, but we want to be slow and sure and careful for everyone's sake...
