CONGRATULATIONS FATHER JAY KORBAN!

GOD BLESS YOU WITH MANY FANTASTIC YEARS OF MINISTRY IN THE ARCHEPARCHY!

Yesterday, here at our Parish Church, His Grace, Metropolitan **Lawrence Huculak**, ordained Deacon **Jay Korban** to the holy Priesthood. The event was solemn, but yet joy-filled as it signified an occasion of hope for the present life and future of Christ's Church here in Manitoba. The pandemic limited the number of people that would have wanted to be present, but the invitees were joined by many others 'online' via livestreaming connections. Archbishop **Stefan Soroka** was also in attendance as were several other priests. His father-in-law, Fr. **Ivan Nahachewsky**, from the Eparchy of Saskatoon, served as the *archdeacon* for the rite of ordination. This is great news for the Church here in Manitoba as we now have another energetic and dedicated priest to serve the Lord and His People within the Archeparchy. We at Holy Eucharist Parish perhaps take particular pride from this development since Fr. Jay, who was born and grew up here in Winnipeg, was a parishioner here at Holy Eucharist for many years with his family before entering the Seminary. A few years back, Jay was crowned in marriage to his wife **Sophia** here at this church. God willing, Fr. Jay may come back to serve this parish one day. However, we understand that his first pastoral appointment as a priest will be to the Faithful of the Rossburn and district parishes. Our prayer goes with him. WHAT ARE YOUR GOALS IN LIFE? HOW WILL YOU BEST SERVE THE LORD AND HIS PEOPLE?

"... offer yourselves to God as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God.... Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but **be transformed by the renewing of your mind**. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is - His good, pleasing and perfect Will." (Romans 12:1-2, but read the whole chapter!)

"For the Kingdom of Heaven is like the landowner who went out early one morning to hire workers for his vineyard... later, he went out and saw others standing around... **'Why do you stand here idle all day?'** They said to him, 'Because no one has hired us.' He said to them, 'You go into the vineyard too.' (Matthew 20:1-6, but read the whole parable!)

Why should **you** consider a priestly or religious vocation? Why should you invite **your children and grandchildren** to consider such a vocation - to be a Priest or Deacon or religious Sister or Monk? Because... they would have a **satisfying** life - one that can be challenging at times, but a life in which there is never a dull moment. It would be a life filled with ministry that is appreciated by countless more people than those who don't understand or want that ministry. It is a life filled with moments of unexpected gratitude and grace from the Lord and from the people that you have the privilege to serve, to help, to support, to befriend. It is a life by which you always have the Lord as your companion. Yes, He is with you every step to inspire, to encourage, to give wisdom and grant miracles. Another big reason is because the Lord and His People need you. Jesus chose this way of ministry, or service for the life of His Church. He says that He came to serve and not to be served and that He calls upon His followers to have the same spirit. He designed the way of the Church to be one of service. That is why we need priests, deacons, religious and monastic women and men (of "consecrated life") to make that service happen in thousands of different kinds and ways of ministry. Give it some honest thought and prayer. Be quiet and let the Lord speak and listen! Think of those priests and sisters and deacons and monks that caught your interest and perhaps inspired you (not the ones that disappointed you or even hurt you - although you need to pray for those too and understand that even they need continuous renewal and need to stay strong with the Lord... by your prayers). Think of the priest or sister that you like... that you would like to be.... that **you** can be...!
