This Thursday we celebrate the feast of the Transfiguration of our Lord. Please plan to attend - either in person at our Church or via livestreaming online. Not only because it is a **day of obligation** (a day, aside from every Sunday, when Ukrainian Catholics are to attend the Divine Liturgy c. 114, §1, 11), but because it is truly an inspiring celebration of an extraordinary moment in Christ's earthly ministry with a profound message for His Church and for each of us personally.

Jesus took three of His Apostles out for a walk one day. They ascended the mountain, Mount Tabor, as Jesus spoke to them, explaining things to them and encouraging them. He knew that just around the corner that they will experience unexpected, even shocking things. Jesus will be handed over (will surrender Himself) to the hatred and violence of His enemies. The Apostles will be terrified and persecuted and they will think that all is lost. Jesus wants to show them that these things must come to pass, but it will only seem that all is lost. Jesus is Lord. He is God and He will rise again and He is already victorious as is His Church and those that remain faithful to Him and keep His Word. On Mount Tabor, Jesus even shows them a glimpse of His divine glory that they would know and remember that He is not only the Messiah, but He is God. Just around the corner in our day, the Church will face unexpected challenges and even shocking things. Let us be inspired and strengthened in our Faith and dedication to our Lord through our celebration of the Transfiguration of our Lord, Who tells His Apostles and us, "Rise, and have no fear."
