COVID-19 PROVISIONARY PARISH WEEKLY UPDATE - NO. 19

Let us encourage each other not to lose hope, but keep the faith!

This **Pandemic** has taken its toll on us. **We want to be safe** and we are willing to make sacrifices in order that we in no way would be **instrumental in spreading** the virus, or that we would **catch it ourselves**. Yet we get mixed signals from health professionals and from government as to what is really happening and what we should or shouldn't do to "be safe". The obvious contradictions that everyone sees add to the confusion.... shopping, restaurants and casinos and massive uncontrolled gatherings are essential, while gatherings for funerals, weddings and worship are frowned upon and even strongly discouraged! Then there is what's going on in the political realm - in our own country and, basically, throughout the world. Most disheartening to some - besides the daily reports on the alleged spread and death toll of the virus - is the suggestion from some that COVID-19 may be around for a long time yet. Others advocate that even more stringent regulations be put in place - quarantine, mandatory face-mask use, tracking and vaccination. It is often most felt among those that can not see loved ones. Especially the elderly that are denied the much-needed access to their family, their clergy and the outdoors. The Faithful want to get to church to fully participate in their beautiful worship liturgies and receive the Sacraments to sustain their spiritual lives. They know that without their 'Church life' - life itself starts to suffer and fade. Yes, our Metropolitan has given a dispensation to everyone who can't come to church or still fears coming for legitimate health concerns. But, what weighs on heart and soul is that as one stays away too long - the zeal begins to fade... and, as the old adage says, "absence makes the heart go wander". Not a few have said how seductive the new normal can be... "we have a dispensation, the attendance numbers are limited, we have livestreaming - Now, we can roll out of bed at the last minute. Sit in our housecoats, flip through the channels, do laundry and check on breakfast or brunch from time to time. Then, eventually, maybe miss from time to time. Then, it will eventually be difficult to "go back". Yes, there's a lot of negatives and uncertainties, but... Our Lord is with us!

We need not - must not - give up hope. There are a lot of great things happening. People are going above and beyond. In our parish, activity has never stopped. Brave volunteers have been working since the earliest days of the pandemic to keep the parish functioning - our administration, our communication, our facilities and, especially, our liturgical and prayer life. Let us continue to see the light in the darkness and grow that light! Let us encourage each other! Let us offer and ask for help! Let us continue "doing something beautiful for God" and the rewards will be ours to harvest.

On August 15th - at 8 AM - Please join from home and bless your fruit basket with holy water



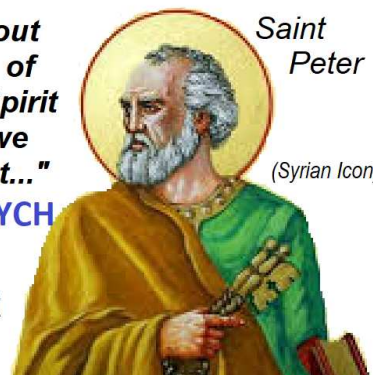
