

## JOIN THE CELEBRATION as we commemorate the 25th anniversary of Father Ed's Priestly Ordination!

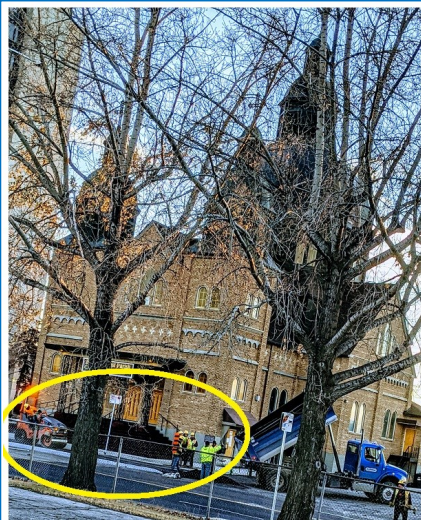
On the morning of November 12th 1995, the soviet Lada "Zhyhul" tried to make its way to the city of Zboriv on roads that were rough to begin with and now were covered with billowing snow. It was a Sunday morning and Deacon Edward Kwiatkowski, was being driven to the church where Bishop Michael Koltun, CSsR planned to ordain him to the priesthood. He was supposed to be ordained the previous week, but inclement weather had the service cancelled. This was the next opening.... If Deacon Ed and the Bishop could both make it. Deacon Ed was a later vocation. Following an early retirement and with the blessing and recommendation of Metropolitan Maxim Hermaniuk, he went to Rome for theology studies. Upon completion of his Rome years, he worked in the Church in Ukraine for a year and then another year as a deacon. Now he was determined to make it to Zboriv. The road was a challenge, but so was the road over the last 5 years. Besides dealing with the emotion of imminent priestly ordination, he was praying for a safe trip. Now the situation was turning to a blizzard. Maybe he would have to wait longer before he could serve as a priest..."

**NEW LEGISLATION COMING**

The federal government has tabled legislation to expand access to euthanasia to people who are not about to die, including people with disabilities.

**DISABILITY ADVOCATES ARE FEARFUL**

A 2019 government report said that people choose euthanasia because of fear of being a burden, loneliness, lack of support, or loss of dignity and meaning. People with disabilities face these issues daily. As a society, we have a responsibility to support the vulnerable, not allow them to be permanently silenced.

**CANADA'S BISHOPS OFFER A WAY TO WITNESS TO YOUR FAITH NOW WHEN IT'S REALLY NEEDED**

As you may recall, the CCCB recently published a statement with respect to the pressing issue of legislation (Bill C-7) currently tabled by the federal government regarding the expansion of euthanasia and assisted suicide ("Medical Assistance in Dying" / "MAiD") beyond people who are near the end of life and has likewise co-signed an ecumenical/interfaith statement as well.

The contacts, consultants and experts with whom the CCCB has been working inform us that **WRITING AND SENDING COMMUNICATIONS TO ONE'S MEMBER OF PARLIAMENT IS AN EFFECTIVE WAY TO GET ONE'S MESSAGE ACROSS.**

Given time and healthcare constraints, electronic mail seems to be the most expedient and effective option at this stage. In order to facilitate the communication, Deacon **Larry Worthen** from the **Coalition for HealthCARE and Conscience** has provided a platform to **reach one's Member of Parliament easily**, as well as an online **sample letter** which can be rewritten or modified by any person wishing to use it.
