



YEAR OF SAINT JOSEPH

The event that took place was when Pope Blessed Pius IX confirmed St. Joseph, the Spouse of the Virgin Mary as "Patron of the Catholic Church". This is truly an unexpected and uplifting announcement that ushers in a myriad of opportunities! Saint Joseph, as Pope Francis writes in his Apostolic Letter to initiate the year, represents a so many strong and endearing chharacteristics of a "father" .. a father that we all would recognize. He says that St. Joseph is "a beloved father, loving father, obedient tender and an an accepting father; a father who is creatively courageous, a working father, a father in the shadows.

"CHRISTMAS CONFESSION"?


