


To celebrate a special event that - surprisingly took place only 150 years ago - Pope Francis has declared the

YEAR OF SAINT JOSEPH

The event that took place was when Pope Blessed Pius IX confirmed St. Joseph, the Spouse of the Virgin Mary as "Patron of the Catholic Church". This is truly an unexpected and uplifting announcement that ushers in a myriad of opportunities! Saint Joseph, as Pope Francis writes in his Apostolic Letter to initiate the year, represents a so many strong and endearing chharacteristics of a "father" .. a father that we all would recognize. He says that St. Joseph is "a beloved father, loving father, obedient tender and an father. а an accepting father; a father who is creatively courageous, a working father, a father in the shadows.

This year we will explore the person of Saint Joseph and his role in salvation history. We will explore fatherhood in the light of



[Pope Francis specifically announced this year in the midst of the Pandemic that we are now experiencing and he explains this in his Apostolic Letter that he named "Patris Corde" - which translates from the Latin as "With the Heart of a Father".

The life and times of Blessed Pope Pius IX are truly amazing and... they are very similar to our own when the secular world is promoting a "reset". Something akin to this was happening in Pius' day where the life of the Church was curtailed and many tumultuous things were happening in the



world. Under Pope Pius' leadership and by his placing the Church under the patronage of the brave and humble and holy St Joseph .. the Church made it through and was stronger and more celebrated than ever

At the close of his Apostolic Letter, Pope Francis included a prayer to Saint Joseph

"We need only ask Saint Joseph for the grace of graces: our conversion. Let us now make our praver to him:

Hail, Guardian of the Redeemer, Spouse of the Blessed Virgin Mary. To you God entrusted his only Son; in you Mary placed her trust; with you Christ became man.

Blessed Joseph, to us too, show yourself a father and guide us in the path of life. Obtain for us grace, mercy and courage, and defend us from every evil. Amen."


