

18), "...the "just" man of Nazareth [Joseph] possesses the clear characteristics of a husband. Luke refers to Mary as "a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph" (Lk 1:27). Even before the "mystery hidden for ages" (Eph 3:9) began to be fulfilled, the Gospels set before us the image of husband and wife. According to Jewish custom, marriage took place in two stages: first, the legal, or true marriage was celebrated, and then, only after a certain period of time, the husband brought the wife into his own house. Thus, before he lived with Mary, Joseph was already her "husband." Mary, however, preserved her deep desire to give herself exclusively to God. ... From the moment of the Annunciation, Mary knew that she was to fulfill her virginal desire to give herself exclusively and fully to God precisely by becoming the Mother of God's Son. Becoming a Mother by the power of the Holy Spirit was the form taken by her gift of self: a form which God himself expected of the Virgin Mary, who was "betrothed" to Joseph... The fact that Mary was "betrothed" to Joseph was part of the very plan of God. This is pointed out by Luke and especially by Matthew.... Addressing Joseph through the words of the angel, God speaks to him as the husband of the Virgin of Nazareth. What took place in her through the power of the Holy Spirit also confirmed in a special way the marriage bond which already existed between Joseph and Mary. God's messenger was clear in what he said to Joseph: "Do not fear to take Mary your wife into your home." Hence, what had taken place earlier, namely, Joseph's marriage to Mary, happened in accord with God's will and was meant to endure. In her divine motherhood Mary had to continue to live as "a virgin, the wife of her husband" (cf. Lk 1:27)."

"It's my Mom. Don't take her away."

This quote is from the heartbreaking scene from the film **Fatal Flaws**, uttered by a woman who's mother was slated for "MAID".

WE ALL CAN AND **NEED** TO TAKE SOME ACTION REGARDING BILL C-7

From the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops... "As you know, the Senate has amended Bill C-7. If these amendments pass the House of Commons, it will make it much easier for vulnerable Canadians to access assisted suicide and euthanasia. The most concerning amendments are:

- 1. Allowing people to write advance directives that **require** euthanasia to be administered if they are **sick** or **disabled** and **lose the ability** to **make** their **own medical decisions**.
- 2. **Removing** the **restriction** on euthanasia for people whose primary diagnosis is **mental illness**. This change will automatically come in to effect 18 months after the Bill is passed.

The Senate's amendments will soon be sent back to the House of Commons for approval.

Write to your MP today, before the sun goes down! Ask your MP to reject the Senate's amendments. If you and I don't start doing something, Canada is lost. [It wasn't long ago that we condemned things like Nazi Germany's 'Aktion T4' and now we're heading there]

WE NEED TO BE VIGILANT AND CAUTIOUS, BUT... LET'S GET BUSY...!

We can now have in-person attendance at 10% capacity at our church services. Funerals, Weddings and Baptisms - 10 participants. We are exploring what can happen in our parish centre and church auditorium. We can do more things! To make it happen according to the directives of our Metropolitan-Archbishop (who bases his directives on the Public Health Orders issued by our government), we need people to step forward and volunteer their assistance. For example, if you come to a church service, offer to help with ushering and help sanitize your area. Follow the regulations and directions given by the ushers. Please, sorry, but we cannot congregate at this time. Not at the back of the church, NOT outside the church. For the time being, get into and away asap and then call the people you saw and chat about the experience from your home (or your car, etc.) When you preregister or show up for a service, you will have to provide your Name, Surname and Contact number. [Alas, as numbers are limited, sometimes people may be declined but just to allow others the opportunity] If you are feeling ill or have been travelling or have been in contact with someone who has had the coronavirus, please refrain from coming at this time. When you come, please do follow the rules. - esp. face covering, social distance, no loitering.

But the real thing right now is... **WE NEED <u>MORE</u> VOLUNTEERS** for **ushering** and **sanitizing**. Those wanting to attend in-person will be asked to volunteer occasionally.

As our Annual General Meeting approaches, we find ourselves once again contemplating the needs of our Parish and the need for volunteers and staff to oversee the daily activity of our parish. One position that is resurfacing is Parish Centre Events Manager. If you have or someone you know has (or would like to have) experience overseeing the scheduling and booking of events at our parish centre please speak/email our Parish Priest Fr. 
