#### Let's Review the Parish Covid Caution Protocols

Okay. I know that we're all tired of covid reports (and fear-mongering), but we also do want to **be careful**. So, let's refresh our memory with the basics one more time just to be clear about what our parish protocols are. (Based on Archeparchial and Governmental directives)

Masks - To attend church services and other functions, everyone is required to wear a mask or appropriate face-shield. It may be removed only by designated singers, readers and speakers and only when they are exercising their duty. They, of course, may also be removed when receiving Holy Communion. Or if experiencing trouble breathing, but only briefly.

Sanitizing - please use the sanitizing liquids and wipes when entering and/or leaving the church. Please sanitize your place before leaving (this will be of great assistance to the staff that will do a more thorough sanitizing later).

**Singing** - Sorry, but only the designated singers may sing at this time. You may only perhaps sing quietly "under your breath" if you so desire.

Registering - We are trying to develop the most streamlined method, but the bottom line is that each individual attending a service must give a name and telephone number. If you call in advance - and your call has been acknowledged (i.e. to be sure that you called in time) then you may come to attend the event, all other things being considered. You might be able to just come the day of, but there might not be room as we are limited to 25% capacity right now. However, know that on Sundays the 8:00 am service often has more space than the 10:00 am. Weekday liturgies are usually okay.

**Be honest** (with yourself and others) - If you have been **travelling**, or have been in contact with someone diagnosed **with covid** (or suspects that they *might have it*) or if you are feeling any flulike symptoms (**cough**, **fever**, etc.) please don't come. Watch online until it passes.

**Gathering** - no gathering or chatting **in or around the church!** Yes, small outdoor group gatherings are permitted, but take it **away from the church** and stay socially distanced all the same. Yes, we want to socialize, but for the time being so that you do not compromise your parish or your fellow-parishioners, please do not do that. Go home, and get on the phone and discuss all afternoon the Scripture readings that your heard and the sermon, etc.

Pray - please keep your fellow-parishioners in your prayer and your parish and your Church so that we will make it through this crisis intact and that Holy Week and Easter will not be denied us again.


