



WE ALL CAN AND **NEED** TO TAKE SOME ACTION REGARDING BILL C-7

From the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops... "As you know, the Senate has amended Bill C-7. If these amendments pass the House of Commons, it will make it much easier for vulnerable Canadians to access assisted suicide and euthanasia. The most concerning amendments are:

1. Allowing people to write advance directives that **require** euthanasia to be administered if they are **sick** or **disabled** and **lose the ability** to **make** their **own medical decisions**.

2. **Removing** the **restriction** on euthanasia for people whose primary diagnosis is **mental illness**. This change will automatically come in to effect 18 months after the Bill is passed.

The Senate's amendments will soon be sent back to the House of Commons for approval. <u>Write to your MP today</u>, before the sun goes down! Ask your MP to reject the Senate's amendments. The organization Coalition for Healthcare and Conscience, found at: www.canadiansforconscience.ca which makes such contacting your MP much easier. Please pray about this and act TODAY. If you and I don't start doing something, Canada is lost. [It wasn't long ago that we condemned things like Nazi Germany's 'Aktion T4' and now we're heading there]


