Can you help out?

As you know, the 35-year-old roof on our Parish Centre needed urgent redoing as the leaking and damage was only increasing.

Well, we paid it from our rainy day fund (very appropriate) which is now left greatly depleted. It

now stands at **-\$96,000.00**

We want to clear this debt to bring our parish funds back up to where they were for many years - to keep our parish financially secure and to allow us to expand into new programs that the "new normal" insists upon [like better online connections, meetings and outreach.... Development of quality online videos and materials... pastoral ministries that can be accomplished in a safe way according to protocols, etc.] Replenishing the funds has been going very slowly as the pandemic has really curtailed some of our typical income (some things like "rentals" have been reduced to a trickle and the near future isn't very promising!). So we're reaching out to our parishioners to consider making a **special donation** for this purpose. It will be like reinvesting back into your parish for the future of your parish!

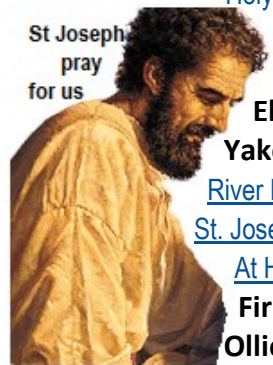
