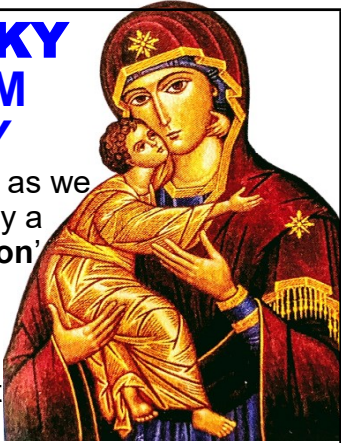

rendering...

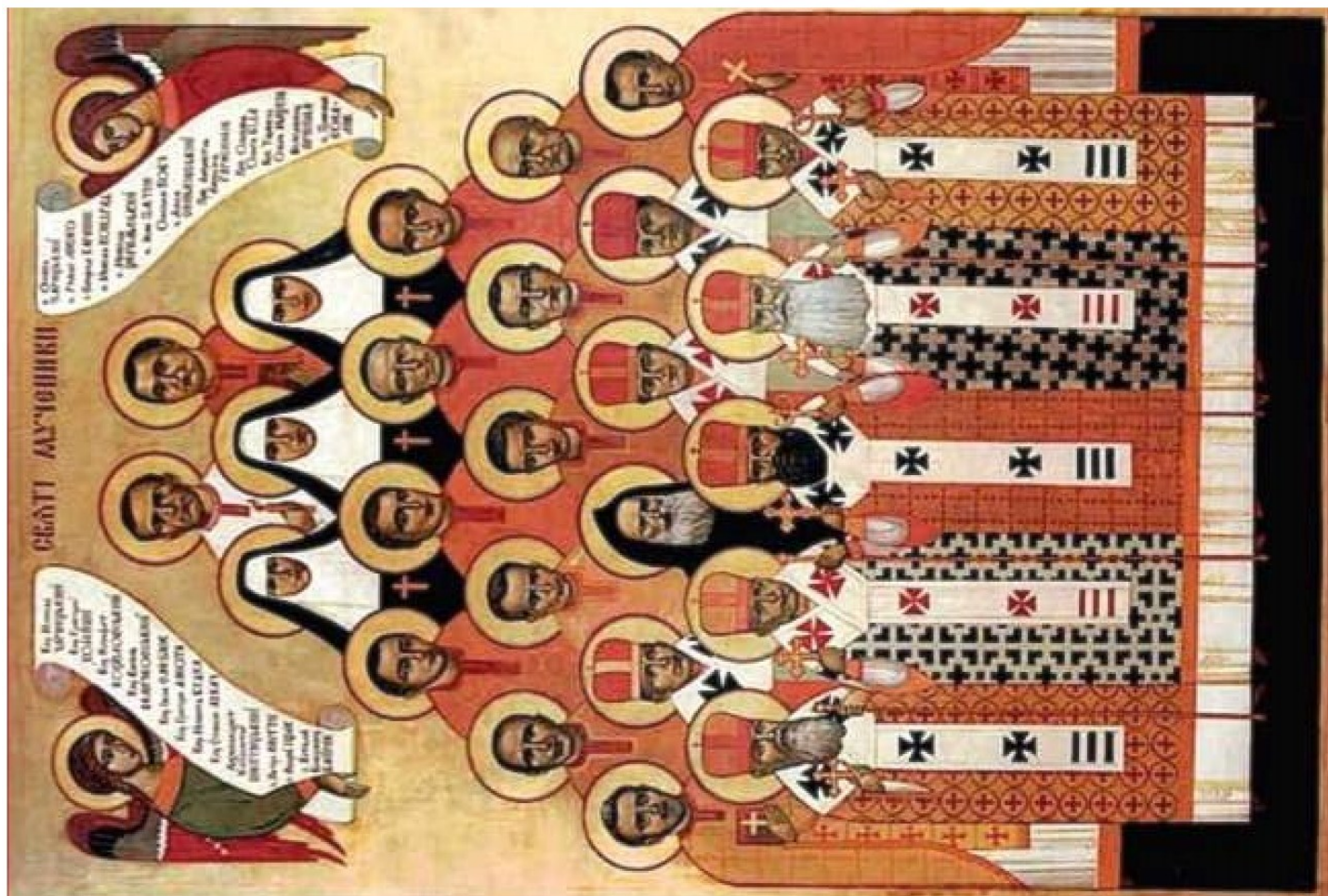
*"An indulgence is a remission

even clearer layman's terms, this means that a person that would have to spend a length of time in Purgatory to
justly and fully atone for their sin before entering into heaven could have their time in Purgatory completed as
"time served" because of your kindness by your interceding for that person by doing the required prayers and
actions here during special times declared by the Church! (Matthew 16:19)

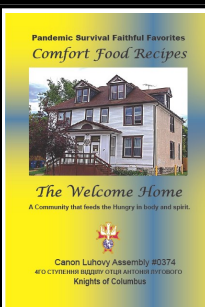
