


### The Death of Saint Joseph

Today, albeit somewhat belated according to our "green holidays" Pentecost tradition, we are remembering and praying for people that are greatly loved and/or important to us and/or are respected by us. Their passing from this life

saddens us. Yet we know by the gift of our Catholic Faith that we are not at all separated forever, but only for a period of time. The Lord has unequivocally promised resurrection and eternal life to those who are baptized into Him and who live a life of faith according to His Holy Will. By His grace we will be re-united with all those that have passed from this life before us and those that will eventually pass from this life after us when they have competed their earthly journey. This being the Year of Saint Joseph, we can turn to the Holy Family and, perhaps Mary the Mother of God in particular, to consider the mystery of the death of our loved ones. Jesus and Mary lost their spouse and foster father when Joseph died and Mary, of course, also lost her beloved Son Jesus, when He

was put to death (...before her eyes. She was present at both of these deaths). According to tradition, St. Joseph, in the last eight years of his life suffered from various illnesses. Mary cared for him in those years. She prayed that the Lord would grant Joseph a peaceful death and that he would be granted a heavenly reward appropriate to his heroic and selfless caring for the Holy Family. Finally, the day before he died, St. Joseph experienced an extraordinary joy and peace and closeness to the Lord that it was all that he desired. When he knew his end was at hand he asked for a blessing and Mary asked Jesus to bless him. Jesus took Joseph into His arms and they had a brief conversation and Jesus blessed him and Joseph died in His arms. Jesus closed his foster father's eyes. He was just over sixty years old. 
