OUR MOTHER OF PERPETUAL HELP

Матері Божої Неустанної Помочі

The icon of Our Lady of Perpetual Help is painted on wood, with background of gold. It is Byzantine in style and is supposed to have been painted in the thirteenth century. [In some places, as in the England and Canada the title has been adopted as Our Lady of Perpetual 'Succour' which is a more European word for the same thing - "aid"... Italian: soccorso, French: secour, etc.]. It represents the Mother of God holding the Divine Child while the Archangels Michael and Gabriel present before Him the instruments of His Passion. Over the figures in the picture are some Greek letters which form the abbreviated words Mother of God, Jesus Christ, Archangel Michael, and Archangel Gabriel respectively. It was brought to Rome towards the end of the fifteenth century by a pious merchant, who, dying there, ordered by his will that the picture should be exposed in a church for public veneration. It was exposed in the church of San Matteo, Via Merulana, between St. Mary Major and St. John Lateran. Crowds flocked to this church, and for nearly three hundred years many graces were obtained through the intercession of the Blessed Virgin. The picture was then popularly called the Madonna di San Matteo. The church was served for a time by the Hermits of St. Augustine, who had sheltered their Irish brethren in their distress. These Augustinians were still in charge when the French invaded Rome (1812) and destroyed the church. The picture disappeared; it remained hidden and neglected for over forty years, but a series of providential circumstances between 1863 and 1865 led to its discovery in an oratory of the Augustinian Fathers at Santa Maria in Posterula.

The pope, Pius IX, who as a boy had prayed before the picture in San Matteo, became interested in the discovery and in a letter dated 11 Dec., 1865 to Father General Mauron, C.Ss.R., ordered that Our Lady of Perpetual Help should be again publicly venerated in Via Merulana, and this time at the new church of St. Alphonsus. The ruins of San Matteo were in the grounds of the Redemptorist Convent. This was but the first favour of the Holy Father towards the picture. He approved of the solemn translation of the picture (26 April, 1866), and its coronation by the Vatican Chapter (23 June, 1867).

Our Mother of Perpetual Help continued..... He fixed the feast as *duplex secundae classis*, on the Sunday before the Feast of the Nativity of St. John the Baptist, and by a decree dated May, 1876, approved of a special office and Mass for the Congregation of the Most Holy Redeemer. This favour later on was also granted to others. Learning that the devotion to Our Lady under this title had spread far and wide, Pius IX raised a confraternity of Our Lady of Perpetual Help and St. Alphonsus, which had been erected in Rome, to the rank of an arch-confraternity and enriched it with many privileges and indulgences. He was amongst the first to visit the picture in its new home, and his name is the first in the register of the arch-confraternity.

Two thousand three hundred facsimiles of the Holy Picture have been sent from St. Alphonsus's church in Rome to every part of the world. At the present day not only altars, but churches and dioceses (e.g. in England, Leeds and Middlesbrough; in the United States Savannah and in Winnipeg, Canada!) are dedicated to Our Lady of Perpetual Help.

The special Icon has also been popular throughout the Ukrainian Catholic Church, because it is a beautiful icon and it is of true Byzantine style. Over the last century or so, the Ukrainian Redemptorists were very instrumental in spreading its devotion in every land and eparchy in which they served. It wasn't until 2017 that the Synod of Bishops of the Ukrainian Catholic decided to establish an official feast of "Our Mother of Perpetual Help" for our Church that would be celebrated on the first Sunday of July every year.

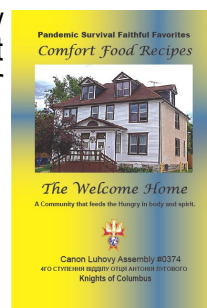
