The Apostles' Fast

The Apostles' Fast was first established at the First Council of Nicaea in 325 AD and is observed from the Monday after All Saints Sunday until and including the day before the Feasts of Sts. Peter and Paul (June 29).

We fast as usual through the week and we abstain from meat and meat products on Wednesdays and Fridays.

Tradition tells us that after the Apostles were filled with the Holy Spirit at Pentecost, they began to fast in order to prepare themselves to go forth and preach the Gospel to the ends of the earth. There are verses in Holy Scripture which are said to have foretold the Apostles' Fast:

And Jesus said to them, "Can you make wedding guests fast while the bridegroom is with them? The days will come, when the bridegroom is taken away from them, and then they will fast in those days." (Luke 5:34-35)

For 2024, the Apostles' Fast is from May 27 to June 28 inclusive and is obligatory for everyone 59 and younger except pregnant and nursing mothers and those involved in hard labour.
